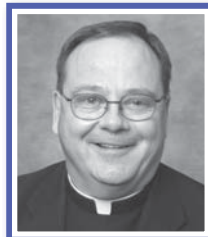

The trustees, who were elected in each municipality to serve the interests of ratepayers of the Board, welcome your input into all aspects of Board business. Delegations to the Board – Individuals or groups, who wish to make a statement about a particular issue or concern, may request to make a presentation as a delegation to the Board at its regular meetings held on the first Tuesday of the month and on the third Tuesday of the month. Written notice to address the Board must be submitted to the Director of Education at least seven days prior to the meeting.

Board meetings start at 8:00 p.m. in the Board Room of the C. G. Byrnes Catholic Education Centre at 802 Drury Lane in Burlington. Board meetings are open to school supporters and to the public.
