## Halton Catholic Board Announces Appointment of New Milton Trustee

The Halton Catholic District School Board is pleased to announce the appointment of **Sandor Koso**, a resident of Milton for 21 years, as the new Catholic School Board Trustee representing Milton for the term of July 2, 2009 to November 30, 2010. He was selected from the 18 applications that the Board received for the position.

Sandor Koso replaces Reverend David Wilhelm, who has served as the Milton Trustee since 2003 and who resigned from the Board, effective June 24, 2009.

“We are very pleased to have Sandor join our Board of Trustees,” notes Board Chair Alice Anne LeMay and “are confident that his strong commitment to community and family and his dedication to Catholic education will enable him to have a positive and meaningful impact on the Milton community and our Catholic school system.”

The Declaration of Office and Oath of Allegiance of Mr. Koso will be administered on July 2, 2009 with his formal installation as a Trustee of the Halton Catholic District School Board at the September 1, 2009 Regular Meeting of the Board.

For the past 12 years, as the Co-op Co-ordinator at the University of Waterloo, Sandor Koso, a professional engineer, has worked closely with university students counseling and assisting them in their search for Co-operative Education employment, as well as with employers in developing opportunities for students in professional environments. Community participation and volunteering has been a large part of the life of this father of three children, who has been active in Cubs, in various roles with the Milton Figure Skating Club. He has also been very involved in the Holy Rosary Catholic Church community – as a Eucharistic Minister, serving on the Pastoral Advisory Council, as a member of the volunteer screening committee for the parish and through the RCIA program, preparing individuals on their journey to become a member of the Catholic faith community. He also volunteers for Catholic Services at the Maplehurst Correctional Complex.
