### 3. Board Update

C. Cipriano shared the following information:

• Catholic Education Week started on May 1st;

- On May 12<sup>th</sup> student leaders in Grades 7 and 8 will gather at St. Elizabeth Seton Catholic Elementary School to be acknowledged for their peer to peer tutoring achievements at the Licensed to Learn (L2L) Leadership Conference;
- On May 19<sup>th</sup> at Holy Trinity the Halton Catholic District School Board (HCDSB) presents, "Festival of Harmony", to showcase the creative and musical talent of students across the HCDSB:
- The <u>Canadian Mental Health Association (CMHA)</u> designates the first week in May as Mental Health Awareness Week. On Sunday, May 13<sup>th</sup> at 8:30 a.m., over 400 HCDSB students and staff, in partnership with the Halton District School Board and <u>Team</u> <u>Unbreakable</u> participated in the 5 KM Run for Youth Mental Health, at Spencer Smith Park, in Burlington;
- During the 2016-2017 school year, the Halton Catholic District School Board (HCDSB)
  was announced as #8 of Ontario's Top 10 Energy Performing School Boards, by

- **Community Rep** Criteria Update C. Cipriano, M. Rictcey and G. Merritt-Murrell met to review the bylaws. Updates have been made based on conversations that were discussed as a committee. Added language around the role of the Community Rep: C. Cipriano provided the committee with the new additions. Discussion followed regarding the new language.
- **Speakers for Webinars Update** A. Gonzalez attended the parent expo and noted there were possible speakers for webinars. Discussion followed regarding possible speakers for the upcoming school year. It was noted that a schedule should be created in September for the entire year to avoid disappointment.
- **CPIC Members-Term 2017-2019** G. Merritt-Murrell shared the 2017-2019 CPIC nominations and candidates. Discussion followed regarding non-Catholic members; It was suggested that the nomination forms should have a section regarding this. This matter will be addressed again in September.
- **OAPCE Halton Director 2017-2018** The Chair called for a vote that D. Garell-Teti continue as the Director for OPACE for 2017-2018. The vote carried.
- 6. **CPIC By-Law Addressing Attendance** C. Cipriano noted that the revised CPIC bylaws were sent out to members with the track changes. The changes are aligned with the thoughts and discussions throughout the year. Discussion followed regarding attendance and the importance of it. It was suggested that the Catholic Council of Charis' Meetings be added as mandatory in the bylaws. The Chair called for a vote to include the Catholic Council of Charis' Meetings in the bylaws as part of the attendance. The vote carried. C. Cipriano will provide the new language and send the revised by-laws with track changes to the committee for review.
- 7. OAPCE Directors Report D. Garell-Teti noted an error on the handout that was provided. The next Directors meeting will be on July 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> in Toronto. The report was discussed.

  OAPCE Rebate Bishop Barron Series was discussed. A. Gonzalez provided further information and feedback on the Catholicism series. She addressed the series for the next school year. The approved \$200 budget was analyzed. A. Gonzalez noted the total for this series went over budget for a total of \$328. The committee discussed the budget. The Chair called for a vote to approve and reimburse the total cost of \$328 for the Catholicism Series. The vote carried. A. Gonzalez will bring further information and cost to the September meeting for future series.
