Notes:

- 1) Effective September 2019, the entrance grade for the French Immersion Program will now be relocated to St. Catherine of Alexandria, which will accommodate Grades 1 to Grade 5. St. Brigid will now accommodate the Grade 6 to Grade 8 cohorts. All existing students that were attending the program effective September 2018 that were in Grade 2 to Grade 5 at St. Brigid will continue until graduation.
- 2) St. Benedict will no longer be a designated Feeder School for the French Immersion Program in the Town of Milton effective September 2019. This is as a result of the program being relocated to St. Scholastica. All existing students that were attending the program effective September 2018 will be grandfathered until graduation. St. Peter will no longer be a designated Feeder School for the Early French Immersion Program in the town of Milton, effective September 2014. This is a result of the program being relocated to St. Benedict. All existing students that were attending the program effective September 2013 will be grandfathered until graduation.
