- v. Live, both in and out of school, a lifestyle and deportment in harmony with Catholic teaching and principles.
- vi. Complete the OECTA/OCSTA Religion Part 1 Course within the first two (2) years of employment with the Halton Catholic District School Board. The Board agrees to pay for this additional qualification.
